

CHAPTER 4 SAMPLE SURVEYS AND EXPERIMENTS

The chapter presents several opportunities for concrete simulations using tools such as a deck of cards, coins, and so on. It is recommended that you use these concrete tools in order to build deeper understanding of random number generation and simulation. You may, however, want to use a calculator to generate random numbers as a complement to the concrete simulations. If you do, be sure to determine whether or not duplication is allowed.
